I can't stan' it!



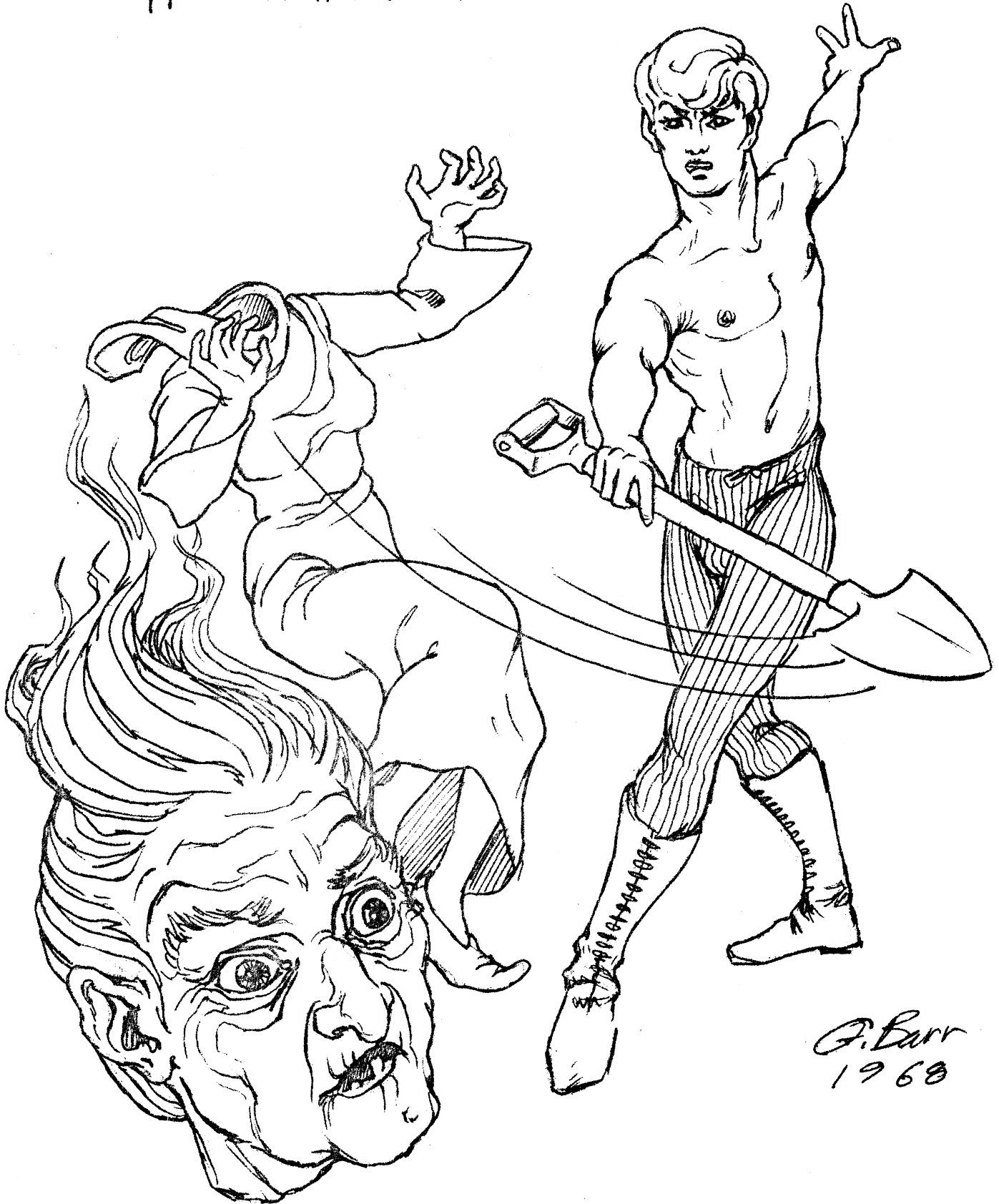
I'll start out this poem with "planet."

And lopped off her head with a shovel.

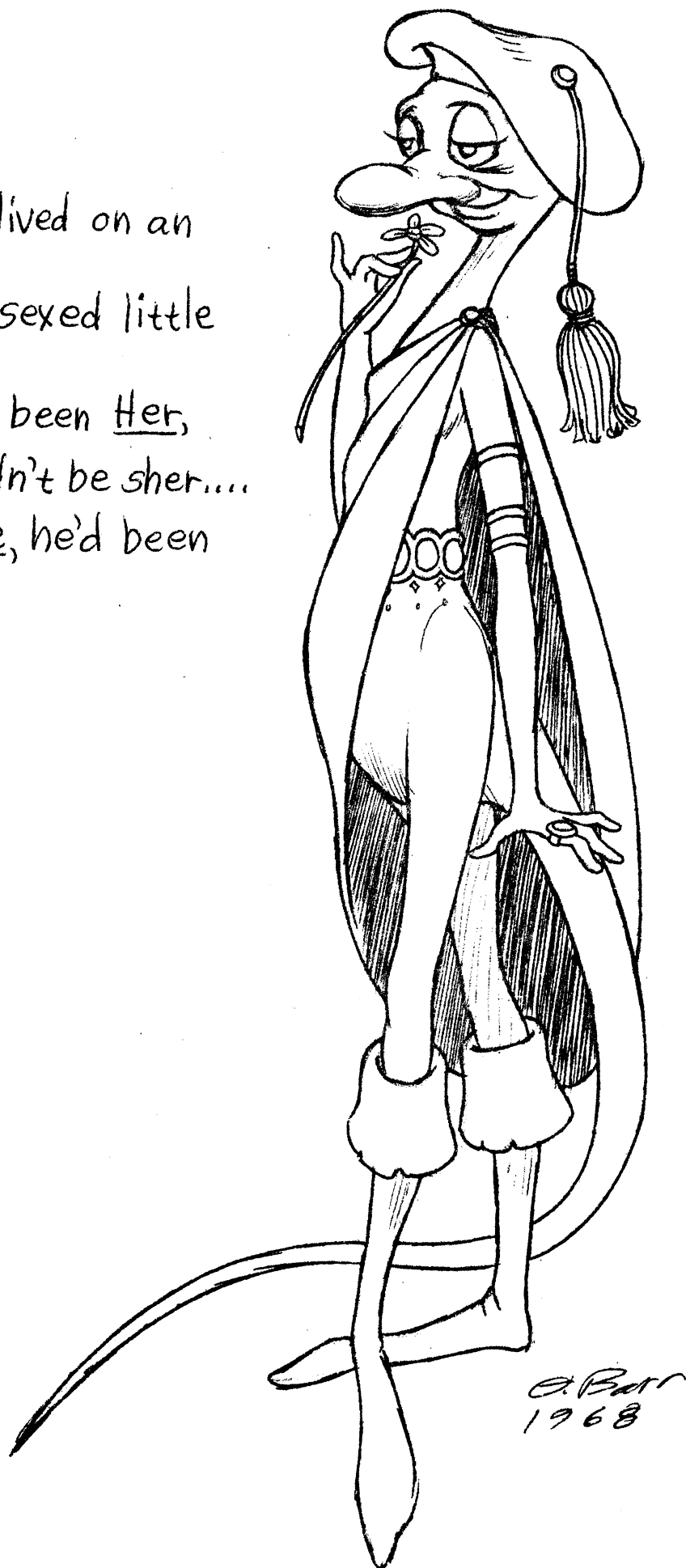

casteroid.



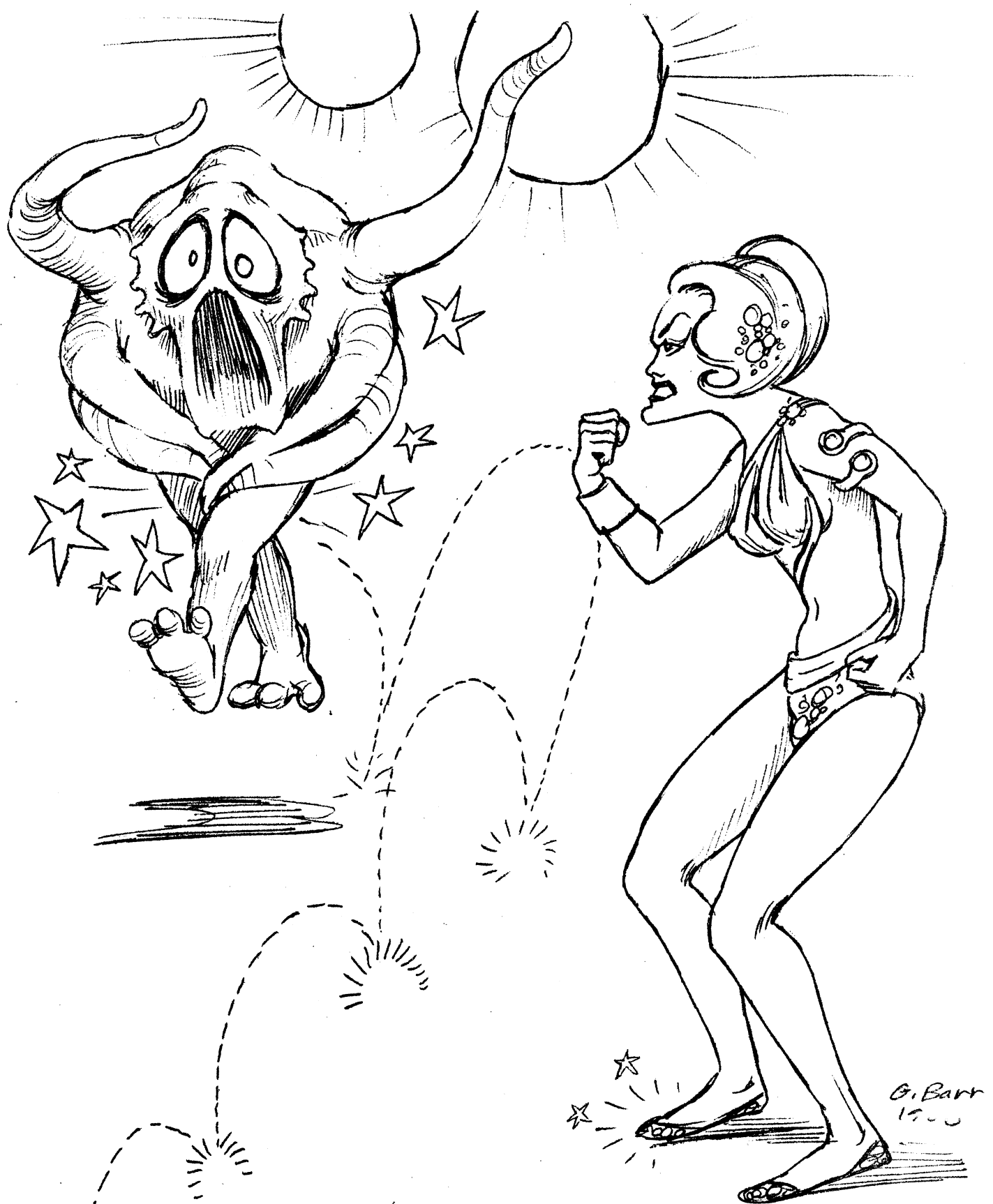
An alien, anthropomorphic,
