In a surprise move, ex-Winnipeg fan Randy "Slowhand" Reichardt returned to Winnipeg, after having forsaken DWF for the more lucrative offer from ESFCAS. League president Mike Glicksohn has decreed that DWF must give up one of the people off thier protected list and a future draft choice. Reichardt, when interviewed by this reporter said, "you should have seen the conditions in Edmonton. How do you expect me to publish with a hand-cranked mimeo?"
